The Micah Project is a non-profit organization\* in Tegucigalpa, Honduras which currently supports 24 young men. These courageous guys, all of whom spent anguished childhoods on the streets or in impoverished homes, are now learning to become Christian leaders through discipleship, formal education, and opportunities to serve others who are in need. Our goal is to support these young men as they learn to ***“act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with their God”*** (Micah 6:8). As you meet these special young men and learn about what they have accomplished through the support of the Micah Project, we believe that you will be blessed by the way God has moved in their lives and in the lives of the people they have touched.



**CHARLES KNOX ALFORD** (November 30, 1992-February 13, 2009) beloved son and brother, passed away suddenly on February 13, 2009, as a result of a truly tragic car accident. Charles, known as "Charlie Bear" by his family and "Chico" by his friends, was an active part of the Micah Project family.
